In addition, Irina has argued several appeals before the U.S. Courts of Appeal, including a Second Circuit case against telecare provider Teladoc Health, Inc., resulting in a rare reversal of the district court's dismissal order. Further, she was actively involved in prosecuting a decade-long case against financial industry leader Goldman Sachs, *In re Goldman Sachs Group, Inc. Securities Litigation*, arising from its Abacus and other subprime mortgage-backed CDOs during the 2008 Financial Crisis, including defending against a precedent-setting appeal of the class certification order to the U.S. Supreme Court and three appeals to the Second Circuit.
